

KEYWORDS EVERY READER SHOULD KNOW

Literature – any type of reading whether it be a poem, novel, short story, etc.

Writing Piece- authors some times refer to literature or an author’s literature as a “piece”

Passage – A passage refers the reading. In some cases it can mean a paragraph or a whole story.

Excerpt – a small portion of a reading that is taken out

Paragraph – a group of sentences. Usually begins with an indent.

Author’s Claim – an argument or point an author is trying to make about a belief or an idea.

Author’s Assertion- an argument or point an author is trying to make about a belief or an idea (similar to claim).

Explicit- when an author directly states information.

Implicit- when an author does not directly state information. You have to be a detective!!!

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
